




A solid base

You can use a clipboard for this, for example, to which you can attach the routing slips.



Different pens

To fill in the form you need a ball-point pen, a yellow pen and a green pen as well as other colored pencils.



Food & clothing

Sturdy shoes, plenty of drinks and a backpack to stow away.

Delbrück city hall

Your discovery tour begins in front of the city hall. Every city has a city hall. It's a very special one Building. A mayor sits there and takes care of the city and its residents.


Each city also has a special symbol: the coat of arms.

It serves as an identifier. So, you know right away where you are. Here you can see the coat of arms of Delbrück. The red berries on the hawthorn (thorn bush) stand for the 10 Delbrücker districts. You can color in your own coat of arms below.

The next station is a central square in Delbrück. There used to be a large field for agriculture here. Grain and vegetables were planted and harvested there. Today this is used as a parking lot, but folk festivals also take place here. At the Katharinenmarkt it is right in the center of the action. At the carnival the children's parade on Sunday and the Shrove Monday parade start and end here. Have you ever been to one of these festivals?

The weekly market also takes place here. On the square then many stands are set up, where you can buy tasty things, for example fruit and vegetables.

On which day of the week does the weekly market take place?




Historical church square: parish church of St. Johannes Baptist

Around the large Catholic Church of St. Johannes, the Baptist you will see many old houses. Houses like this have been around for the Middle Ages. Today they are under monument protection. This means that the houses cannot be demolished.

What do you call the houses where the wooden beams are so beautifully visible?

- half-timbered house wooden house

Now look up at the tower of the church. Can you see that the tower is leaning? Whether the tower was intentionally built with a westerly slope, or whether it has gradually sloped over the centuries, cannot be said with certainty. Today, its tip protrudes a good 2 meters beyond the imaginary center of the tower.

Put one of your pencils on the ground. From there, take two giant steps forward. Now turn around and see how much 2 meters approximately are. The tower is pretty crooked, isn't it?



Town band – musicians' home


Indoor pool
